The Business Plan for Peace

The Business Plan for Peace Project is a practical, in-depth study of how we can achieve peace in this lifetime. It looks at not only the formal peace movement, but also other positive movements, such as social enterprise, socially responsible business, the New thought/New Age movement, anti-poverty and micro-enterprise movements, all of which make up the broader peace movement.

The Business Plan for Peace Project was inspired by the idea that we are already on the way to world peace. But everyone – social enterprises, non-profit organizations, communities, individuals, socially responsible businesses – need to begin to think of themselves as part of the broader peace movement and that all of their actions, from an individual to a global company, are a vital part of this process.

The main outcomes of this project will be a minimum 200 page Business Plan for Peace that will be published as a book and available to all those interested in creating a world at peace, and the founding of the Center for the New Peace. The Center for the New Peace will be founded as a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization during the second year of the project and will implement the strategies outlined in the Business Plan for Peace.
